Geographic Area:

We are located approximately three miles from the Canadian border, southwest of Montreal, Que. Some neighboring towns are Massena, NY and Malone, NY. The district is a rural- farming community but is within driving distance of industry and correctional facilities. The St. Regis Mohawk reservation is part of the school district. Native American students make up 60% of Salmon River's school population.
